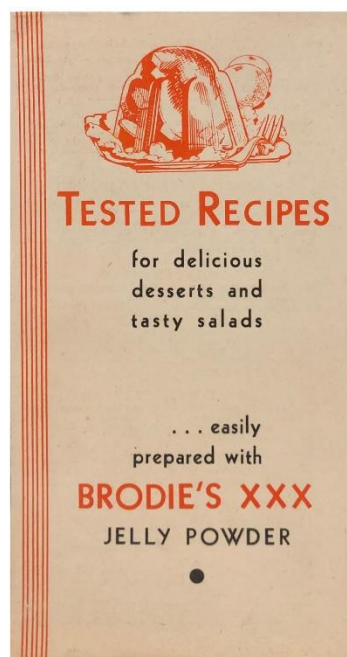

A Selection of Canadian Cookery Books

1. Renaud, Helena. **The Canadian Home Cookbook**. New York: Grosset & Dunlap, [Circa 1939]. pp. x, 394., [14] leaves of plates: ill. (some col.); 22 cm. Near fine in brown cloth with blind-stamped blue lettering to front cover and spine and housed in very good+ colour-illustrated original dust-jacket now housed in protective mylar. Title page and front cover show illustrations of measuring spoons. Remarkably nice condition. Driver (US4.1) states that this is likely an American book, retitled for distribution in Canada - one of the American editions being 'The American Home Cook Book, published by Grosset and Dunlap in 1939. Includes 21 page index. Hardcover.

At time of cataloguing, only one (preserve) listing on AMICUS. Driver, in Culinary Landmarks, pp. 1162-33, lists two known Canadian copies - one preserve copy at L.A.C., mentioned above, and one at North York Central Library (now amalgamated with TPL). Rare.

Stapled card covers. Profusely illustrated, endpapers are comprised of foil. This is a Canadian cookery book featuring (according to the printer of the book - see Driver) the art of A.J. Casson, member of the iconic Canadian Group of Seven artists. See Driver, #0130.1 (p. 919) for a detailed description of this title. Also a colour illustration of the cover of this book is to be found in the illustrations at the centre of Driver's book (unpaginated section). Driver gives the publishing date as about 1949. For a biographical note, re: the author, see Driver, p. 918. Driver notes that margarine, a substitute for butter, was legalized in Canada at the end of 1948. "According to Katy Hodgins, the printer of the book was the Toronto firm Sampson-Matthews, and the art director, A.J. Casson (of Group of Seven fame). Casson's distinctive design incorporated foil leaves at front and back, mimicking Margene's foil wrapper; on the front face of the binding, part of the image of the block of margarine is cut out, revealing the foil leaf behind."
